Summary of Events

June Stats

Burglary of a Motor Vehicle:

18900 North Freeway – Unknown suspect(s) made unauthorized entry into the complainant's vehicle and stole property.

400 Artesia St - Complainant reported that property was stolen from his vehicle while the vehicle was at a known business. Offense did not occur within the neighborhood.

Criminal Mischief:

600 Turley - An unknown suspect(s) damaged the complainant's window.

19500 Lockridge Dr – Property was stolen from the complainant's trailer by male suspect.

Transportation Code Violation:

800 Lynwood Rd - Traffic stop lead to driver being found in possession of drug paraphernalia. The male was cited and released.

FSGI Accident:

18900 Casper Dr- Male subject caused an accident and then fled the scene on foot without

exchanging information. Case is still pending investigation.

Family Disturbance:

600 E Cypresswood Dr – Male brothers were involved in a physical altercation. The Harris County DA's Office declined charges and the males were separated.

Other:

19100 Tyrone St – Complainant reported that known subject kept coming to the residence. The suspect was located and issued a trespass warning.

19000 Lockridge – Complainant reported that he was victim of an attempted online scam. No money was exchanged.

ALARMS – Contract patrol deputies responded to 1 local alarms at various locations within the community. They were handled without incident and were all found to be false alarms.

MUD CHECKS – Contract patrol deputies made 25 Municipal Utility Checks within the community. There were no signs of foul play and all facilities appeared to be in good working order.

OTHER CALLS - Contract and District patrol deputies responded to 68 other calls for service within the community, while maintaining peace and justice in the contracts.

SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES – Contract patrol deputies responded to 1 suspicious vehicles within the community. All these scenes were utilized to gather intelligence and were all cleared without incident after thorough investigations.
