Criminal Mischief:

ALARMS – Contract patrol deputies responded to 3 local alarms at various locations within the community. They were handled without incident and were all found to be false alarms.

MUD CHECKS – Contract patrol deputies made 54 Municipal Utility Checks within the community. There were no signs of foul play and all facilities appeared to be in good working order.

OTHER CALLS - Contract and District patrol deputies responded 73 to other calls for service within the community, while maintaining peace and justice in the contracts.

SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES – Contract patrol deputies responded to6 suspicious vehicles within the community. All these scenes were utilized to gather intelligence and were all cleared without incident after thorough investigations.
